He was a Fulbright scholar and he established the “Membranes for Environmental and Energy Separations Laboratory” (M.E.S.L) in 1985 with main research activities in the fields of development, pore structure characterization and evaluation of performance of nanoporous membranes and membrane intensified processes for CO₂ capture, conversion and desalination. He is author and co-author of more than 170 papers in peer-reviewed journals and the editor of five books. He has participated in 64 national and European projects, in 18 as coordinator. He was the coordinator of the European Network of Excellence **IN-S**itu Study and **DE**velopment of processes involving nano**POR**ous **S**olids (**INSIDE-PORES**) and he served as the president of the National Research Centre Demokritos for the period 2010-2016.
